The meeting was called to order with Members Joyce Gard, Dave Doll, Carol Middlebrook, Susan Moffitt, Town Crew Supervisor Tristan Drake, and Assistant Public Works Carl Brown Grimm present.

Absent: Council Member Nancy Pemberton and Director of Public Works John Mrozinski.

Minutes Approval for July 21, 2026: Dave made a motion to approve the minutes as written and Susan 2nd the motion.

Old Business: Carl brought us up to date with Cemetery Records. Carl has entered all the records into the database. Approximately 6000 burials were entered and 4000 lots were entered. Carl will give a demonstration at next meeting. Carl mention if we want to enter Veteran's information. Joyce has a list of the American Legion and a list she has worked on. The list includes which branch of service, rank and if they served in war.

Tristan gave an update on the monument in the center of section 4. Dave will receive the monument sometime in October and hopefully it will be in the new Cemetery by Thanksgiving.

New Business: Tristan gave update on tree damage in the older section of the Cemetery. We lost 2 big branches of cedar trees and 1 huge cherry tree on the tree line of the Cemetery and the Golf Course. There was no damage to any of the monuments. The Town Crew were able to clean up the cedar branches. KC Trees will cut and remove the cherry tree because the equipment needed would be better suited as it needs to be cleaned up on the Golf Course's side due to the monuments. When that tree is removed the town will work on the big roots of that tree and fill in the hole. The entire area is taped off warning of danger.

Tristan stated Amazon met with John and Tristan about the possibility of donating trees in the 4th addition. The plan for those trees would be to place them along the back of the Cemetery to hide the cornfield and along the south side by Gary Lawson's property.

Carol asked if there was a possibility of adding a water pump so flowers could be watered easier. Tristan will investigate this request.
